I will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.

Participant Code of Conduct

I will control my temper and not let physical or verbal hostility spoil the activity for everyone.

I will respect my teammates, opponents, the coaches & spectators.

I will remember that I am playing a game to have fun, improve skills, make friends and to try my best.

I will acknowledge all good plays and performances, including those of my teammates and my opponents.

Parent/Guardian/Spectator Code of Conduct

I will remember that my child is participating for her or his enjoyment of the game, not mine.

I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflict without resorting to verbal or physical displays of hostility or violence.

I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game.

I will make my child feel like a winner by offering praise for competing fairly and trying hard to the best of his or her ability.

No player will be chastised or verbally abused over the result of a game or mistakes therein.

I will remember that children learn best by example and witness my behavior before, during and after games.

I will applaud good plays or performances by my child's team and her/his opponent's.

I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches who give their time to coach my child.
